



Eviction-related legal costs have increased over the years. What factors do you think






Prior to the pandemic, were you or your staff able to handle eviction cases independently or with non-attorney representatives?








When you use an alternative method before pursuing the legal eviction process, which method(s) do you use?






What is the number one reason why an eviction is dismissed or judgement is rendered in favor of the defendant?
